

Scheme, bearing date the 7th day of April, 1927, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

“ We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in pursuance of the Act of the 16th and 17th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 50, and of the Act of the 23rd and 24th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 124, have prepared, and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Scheme for effecting a transfer of so much as is hereinafter mentioned of the ownership of the Advowson or right of Patronage of and presentation to the Benefice (being a Vicarage) of Codnor and Loscoe, situate in the County of Derby and in the Diocese of Southwell, by way of exchange for so much as is hereinafter mentioned of the Advowson or right of Patronage of and presentation to the Benefice (being a District) of Saint Luke, Loscoe, situate in the same County and Diocese:

“ Whereas under the provisions of the 21st section of the Act of the 6th and 7th years of Her said late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 37, the right of Patronage and presentation to each of the said Benefices of Codnor and Loscoe, and Saint Luke, Loscoe, is at present exercised alternately by Your Majesty and Your Successors and by the Bishop of Southwell for the time being:

“ And whereas it has been proposed to us that the Patronage of the said two Benefices of Codnor and Loscoe, and Saint Luke, Loscoe, should be assigned and transferred by way of exchange in the manner which is hereinafter recommended and proposed:

“ And whereas we have made due inquiry and calculation as to the circumstances and relative value of the said two Benefices and of the Patronage thereof respectively, and we do hereby certify to Your Majesty in Council that the circumstances and present values of the said two Benefices are as set forth in the Schedule hereunto annexed:

“ Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Bernard Oliver Francis, now Bishop of Southwell, as the alternate Patron of the said Benefice of Codnor and Loscoe (in testimony of which consent he has signed this Scheme and has affixed thereto his Epis-

copal Seal), and with the consent of the Right Honourable Stanley Baldwin, now First Lord of Your Majesty's Treasury, acting on behalf of Your Majesty, as the alternate Patron of the Benefice of Saint Luke, Loscoe (in testimony of which consent he, the said Stanley Baldwin, has signed and sealed this Scheme), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, humbly recommend and propose that upon and from the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme and without any conveyance or assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the alternate right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of Codnor and Loscoe which is now, as aforesaid, exercised by the said Bernard Oliver Francis, Bishop of Southwell, shall be transferred from him, the said Bishop, and from his successors in the same Bishopric, and shall thereupon and thenceforth belong to and may from time to time be exercised by Your Majesty. Your Heirs and Successors for ever in such manner that the whole Advowson of the said Benefice of Codnor and Loscoe shall hereafter belong to Your Majesty, Your Heirs and Successors for ever, and that in exchange for the same the alternate right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of Saint Luke, Loscoe, which is now exercised as aforesaid by Your Majesty shall be transferred from Your Majesty, Your Heirs and Successors and shall thereupon and thenceforth belong to and may from time to time be exercised by the said Bernard Oliver Francis, Bishop of Southwell, and his successors, Bishops of Southwell, for ever, in such manner that the whole Advowson of the said Benefice of Saint Luke, Loscoe, shall hereafter belong to the said Bernard Oliver Francis, Bishop of Southwell, and his successors, Bishops of Southwell, for ever.

“ And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts, or of either of them, or of any other Act of Parliament.
