WIDOWS', ORPHANS' AND OLD AGE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACT, 1925.

Notice is hereby given, under the Rules Publication Act, 1898, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health, and the Scottish Board of Health, acting jointly in conjunction with the Treasury, after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the proviso to Section 25 of the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act, 1925, to make regulations to be known as the Contributory Pensions Workmen's Compensation (Valuation) Regulations.
