Provided always that if at any time lands, tithes or other hereditaments sufficient in our opinion to produce the said yearly sum or any part thereof shall be annexed by us to the said Benefice of St. John the Evangelist, Masbrough, in substitu-

tion for such yearly sum or for such part thereof, our liability for the payment of such yearly sum or of such part thereof, as the case may be, shall thereupon and thereafter cease and determine.
