

Road from its junction with the Bury St. Edmunds to Diss Road to the eastern boundary of the parish of Pakenham; the Stanton to Kenninghall Road from its junction with the Bury St. Edmunds to Diss Road (via Hopton) to the boundary of the area of supply; the Ixworth to Walsham-le-Willows Road from its junction with the Bury St. Edmunds to Diss Road to the eastern boundary of the parish of Langham; the Bury St. Edmunds to Thetford Road; the Bury St. Edmunds to Brandon Road from its junction with the Bury St. Edmunds to Thetford Road to the boundary of the area of supply; the Bury St. Edmunds to Mildenhall Road via Lackford from its junction with the Bury St. Edmunds to Thetford Road to the boundary of the area of supply; and the Fornham St. Martin to Honington Road from its junction with the Bury St. Edmunds to Thetford Road to its junction with the Thetford to Stowmarket Road.

Roadways and footpaths on and approaches to the bridges carrying the following roads over—

(i) The London and North Eastern Railway.

The Bury St. Edmunds to Newmarket Road in the parish of Westley; the Fornham St. Martin to Honington Road on the northern boundary of the parish of Fornham St. Martin; the Bury St. Edmunds to Thetford Road in the parish of Barnham; the Bury St. Edmunds to Gedding (via Little Welnetham) Road in the parish of Great Welnetham; the Lavenham to Felsham (via Cockfield) Road in the parish of Cockfield; the Bury St. Edmunds to Lavenham Road in the parish of Lavenham; the Bury St. Edmunds to Diss Road in the parish of Palgrave; in the parish of Palgrave the road north of the Rookery (in the parish of Wortham) from its junction with the Bury St. Edmunds to Diss Road to its junction with the Ipswich to Norwich Road (at a point south-west of Scole); the Stowmarket to Rickingham Road at Finningham Station; the Ipswich to Norwich Road in the parish of Yaxley; the Ipswich to Manningtree Road in the parish of Brantham; and the Ipswich to Tuddenham Road on the north-eastern boundary of the borough of Ipswich.

(ii) The Mid Suffolk Light Railway.

The Ipswich to Norwich Road on the common boundary of the parishes of Mendlesham, and Wetheringsett-cum-Brockford.

(b) Railways:—

(i) The London and North Eastern Railway.

On the Ipswich to Haughley line, the level crossing on the Ipswich to Sproughton Road in the parish of Sproughton, the level crossing at Claydon Station, and the level crossing on the eastern boundary of the urban district of Stowmarket on the Debenham to Stowmarket Road; on the Hadleigh branch line, the level crossing at Capel St. Mary Station; on the Ipswich to Colchester line, the level crossing at

Bentley Station; on the Ipswich to Yarmouth line, the level crossing at Bealings Station; and on the Framlingham branch line, the level crossing in the parish of Framlingham on the Framlingham to Campsey Ash Road.

(ii) The Mid Suffolk Light Railway.

The level crossing at Aspoll and Thordon Station; the level crossing near Applewhite's Farm (in the parish of Old Newton).

4. The streets and parts of streets in which it is proposed that distributing mains shall be laid down within a period to be specified by the Order are:—

In the administrative county of East Suffolk—

(a) In the rural district of Samford—

Parish of East Bergholt—

Main Street of East Bergholt from Richardson's Farm to St. Mary's Church and thence along the Cattawade Road to the White Horse Inn.

In the administrative county of West Suffolk—

(b) In the urban district of Hadleigh—

Parish of Hadleigh—

Bridge Street from Hadleigh Bridge to High Street, High Street, Benton Street from High Street to Station Farm, Angel Street from High Street to Long Bessells, and George Street from High Street to Long Bessells.

(c) In the rural district of Cosford—

Parish of Lavenham—

Church Street from Churchyard to High Street and High Street from Church Street to the Congregational Chapel.

5. The streets and parts of streets and railways outside the area of supply which the Undertakers propose to take special power to break up are:—

(a) Streets—

In the administrative county of West Suffolk—

In the borough of Bury St. Edmunds—

Cattle Market; St. Andrews Street South; St. Andrews Street North; Out Northgate; Fornham Road; Risbygate Street; Northgate Street; Eastgate Street; Great Barton Road; Out Risbygate; Newmarket Road; Westgate Street; Southgate Street; Stowmarket Road; Crown Street; and Angel Hill.

In the administrative county of East Suffolk—

In the borough of Eye—

The Ipswich to Diss Road and the Eye to Thornham Parva Road.

In the urban district of Woodbridge—

The Ipswich to Great Yarmouth Main Road.

In the urban district of Saxmundham—

The Ipswich to Great Yarmouth Main Road and the Saxmundham to Debenham Main Road.
