COUNTY OF DEVON.

Notice is hereby given that on the ninth day of August, 1927, the Minister of Transport made an Order under Section 7 (4) of the Roads Act, 1920, amending a previous Order made by him under that Sub-Section on the 2nd August, 1924, in respect of certain roads in the County of Devon.

The original Order provided, amongst other things, that for a period of three years from the 1st September, 1924, no person should drive or cause to be driven any locomotive, any heavy motor car (as defined by Article II of the Heavy Motor Car Order, 1904) or any motor car with seats for more than fourteen persons exclusive of the driver, on—

Crowder's Hill from Elm Road west of Lovering Farm to its junction with Brixington Lane about 500 yards south-west of Marley House.

Road from Crowder's Hill at Lovering Farm via Symonds' Farm and Hulham Farm to its junction with Elm Road west of Hulham Farm.

Brixington Lane from the road junction near the Kennels passing east of Marley House and west of Brixington Farm to its junction with the Withycombe Raleigh—Withycombe Barton road at Ash Cottages.

Maer Lane from Maer Road near the Sand Pit via Maer Farm, Spratts Hayes, Littleham, Castle Cottages and Knowle Hill Plantations to the boundary of the Saint Thomas Rural District at Knowle Hill Cottages.

The effect of the amending Order of the 9th August, 1927, is to substitute a period of "five years" in respect of the provision cited above for the period of "three years" mentioned in the original Order.
