I, WILLIAM THOMAS FRANCIS HORWOOD, Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby APPOINT Standings for Hackney Carriages at the following places, and do make the following Regulations with regard to the Boundaries for the same, viz. :—

| AT BERKELEY STREET, W. | Two Hackney Carriages : In the centre of roadway, commencing at a point in line with the entrance to No. 29, Berkeley Street, and extending Northward as far as necessary for two carriages. Front of vehicles toward the South. NOTE.—This Standing will be available only between the hours of 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. |

| AT HORN LANE, ACTON... | Three Hackney Carriages : On the West side of roadway, commencing at a point ten yards South of Tram Standard No. 115, situate in Horn Lane, and extending Southward, by kerb, as far as necessary for three carriages. Front of vehicles toward the North. |

| AT LENNOX GARDENS AND MILNER STREET, CHELSEA. | Four Hackney Carriages : In two portions, and do make the following Regulations with regard to the Boundaries for the same, viz. :— <i>First Portion.</i> —Two carriages to stand abreast at the South end of Lennox Gardens immediately North of lamp standard in the centre of roadway. Front of vehicles toward the North. <i>Second Portion.</i> —Two carriages to stand by the kerb on the South side of Milner Street, commencing at a point in line with the Eastern building wall of St. Simon Zelotes Church and extending Eastward as far as necessary for two carriages. Front of vehicles toward the West. The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion. |

Provided that no Hackney Carriage shall be suffered to stand across any street or thoroughfare, or opposite the end of any street or carriage-way, or upon any place where foot-passengers usually cross the carriage-way.
