The KING has been pleased to give and grant unto Edgar John Lewellyn, Esq., His Majesty's Royal licence and authority to wear the Cross of Chevalier of the Legion of Honour, which Decoration has been conferred upon him by the President of the French Republic, in recognition of valuable services rendered by him.

employed in the afternoon shift in consecutive weeks and that a woman or young person shall not be allowed to lift, carry or move anything so heavy as to be likely to cause injury to such woman or young person.
