LOWESTOFT ELECTRICITY  
(EXTENSION) SPECIAL ORDER.APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT OF DRAFT  
SPECIAL ORDER.

**N**OTICE is hereby given, that application has been made to the Electricity Commissioners by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Lowestoft (hereinafter called "the Corporation") whose office is situate at the Town Hall Lowestoft to amend the Draft of a Special Order under the above name or short title for which application has been made to the said Commissioners by the Corporation under the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1926, so as to provide that the streets and parts of streets in which electric lines shall be laid down within a period specified in the Order shall be the streets and parts of streets hereinafter described in substitution for those originally described in the Third Schedule to the Draft Order.

The streets and parts of streets above referred to are as follows:—

In the Rural District of Mutford and Lothingland:—

In the Parish of Carlton Colville:—  
Elm Tree Road.

In the Parish of Oulton:—

Yarmouth Road from Sandy Lane to four cross roads near Pound Farm.

In the Parish of Gunton:—

The Lowestoft-Great Yarmouth Road from the boundary of the Borough of Lowestoft to the mile-stone at the foot of Foxburrow Hill.

In the Parish of Kessingland:—

The Lowestoft-London Road from Field Lane to "The Grove."  
Whites Lane.  
Church Road.  
Road from King's Head Inn to White's Lane.

Every local or other public authority, company or person desirous of bringing before the

Electricity Commissioners any objections respecting the application may do so by registered letter addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Savoy Court, Strand, London, W.C. 2, and posted on or before the 15th day of October, 1927, and a copy of such objections must also be forwarded to the undersigned Town Clerk or Parliamentary Agent.

## ELECTRICITY (SUPPLY) ACT, 1926.

SOUTH-EAST ENGLAND ELECTRICITY  
SCHEME, 1927.

**W**HEREAS the Electricity Commissioners have prepared and transmitted to the Central Electricity Board a Scheme bearing the above short title and relating specifically to—

The Administrative Counties of Cambridge, the Isle of Ely, the Soke of Peterborough, Huntingdon, Hertford, Middlesex, Essex, London, Surrey, Kent and East Sussex;

Parts of the Administrative Counties of Bedford, Oxford, Buckingham, Berks, Southampton, West Sussex, East Suffolk and West Suffolk; and

The County Boroughs of Reading, Ipswich, East Ham, West Ham, Southend-on-Sea, Canterbury, Croydon, Brighton, Eastbourne and Hastings;

and dealing with the matters mentioned in Section 4 (1) of the Electricity (Supply) Act, 1926.

Notice is hereby given that the Central Electricity Board have caused the said Scheme to be published and that any authorised undertakers or other persons interested in the said Scheme and desiring to make representations thereon may do so by forwarding the same by registered letter addressed or by delivering the same (in each case) not later than the 15th day of November, 1927, to the undersigned.
