CANCELLATION OF STANDINGS FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGES.

By virtue of the Act 13 and 14 Victoria, chapter 7, intituled "An Act for Consolidating the Office of the Registrar of Metropolitan Public Carriages with the Office of Commissioners of Police of the Metropolis, and making other provisions in regard to the Consolidated Offices."

I, WILLIAM THOMAS FRANCIS HORWOOD, Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby CANCEL the appointments of the following Standings for Hackney Carriages at the following places:—

22nd September, 1927 :-

CANCELLATIONS.

AT SHAFTESBURY AVENUE.

Twenty-six Hackney Carriages in eight portions:

First Portion.—One carriage in centre of roadway, to stand immediately North of refuge opposite Trocadero Restaurant.

Second Portion.—Five carriages in centre of roadway, commencing opposite entrance to No. 28, Shaftesbury Avenue.

Third Portion.—One carriage in centre of roadway, to stand immediately South of refuge at Rupert Street.

Fourth Portion.—Three carriages in centre of roadway, commencing at a point opposite the building line of Globe Theatre.

Fifth Portion.—Two carriages in centre of roadway, commencing at a point 12 yards South of refuge South of Wardour Street.

Sixth Portion.—Three carriages in centre of roadway, commencing opposite entrance to No. 53 Shaftesbury Avenue.

Seventh Portion.—Three carriages in centre of roadway, commencing opposite entrance to No. 67, Shaftesbury Avenue, extending to South end of refuge.

Eighth Portion.—Eight carriages in centre of roadway, commencing two yards from crossing North of Dean Street.

Front of vehicles of each portion toward the South.

The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion, the second from the third, the third from the fourth, the fourth from the fifth, the fifth from the sixth, the sixth from the seventh, and the seventh from the eighth portions.

21st September, 1927:—

AT YORK ROAD, CAMDEN ROAD.

Eight Hackney Carriages:

Commencing 15 feet from Camden Road and extending along the centre of York Road a sufficient distance for eight Hackney carriages to stand.

Horses' heads towards Camden Road.

21st September, 1927:-

AT HOLLOWAY ROAD AND TUFNELL PARK ROAD. Thirteen Hackney Carriages in two portions:

First Portion.—One carriage in the centre of Holloway Road, between the inner lines of the tramway metals, immediately North of street refuge and opposite No. 458, Holloway Road.

Horse's head Southward.

Second Portion.—Twelve carriages in the centre of Tufnell Park Road, commencing at the foot crossing at junction of Holloway Road, and extending Westward as far as necessary.

Horses' heads Eastward.

The first portion of the Standing is to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.
