HARBOURS DOCKS AND PIERS (TEMPORARY INCREASE OF CHARGES) ACTS 1920 TO 1922.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Ilfracombe Pier and Harbour (Temporary Increase of Charges) Order 1926 will cease to have effect

on the 31st December 1927, and that the Ilfracombe Urban District Council has made application to the Minister of Transport for an Order under the Harbours Docks and Piers (Temporary Increase of Charges) Acts 1920 to 1922, conditionally on those Acts being extended as proposed by the Expiring Laws Continuance Bill now before Parliament, modifying their statutory maximum charges until the 31st December 1928. The statutory power of charge prescribed by the Ilfracombe Harbour Order 1870, is (inter alia) as follows:—

For every passenger without luggage and having a return ticket who shall land from and re-embark on board the same steam or other vessel or boat within any twenty-four hours any sum not exceeding 2d.

The charge, at present authorised by the above Order, for every such passenger is 3d.

It is proposed that the said charge of 3d. shall be continued until the 31st December 1928.

Notice is hereby further given that any persons desirous of making representations to the Minister of Transport with respect to the application may do so by letter addressed to the Assistant Secretary, Finance Department, Ministry of Transport, 7, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W. 1, within fourteen days of the date of the publication of this notice.
