WREXHAM GAS.

(Application of the Wrexham Gas Company for a Special Order under Section 10 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920.)

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made to the Board of Trade by the Wrexham Gas Company (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") whose address is 23, Salop-road, Wrexham, in the County of Denbigh, for a Special Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") under Section 10 of the Gas Regulation Act 1920 for all or some of the following purposes, that is to say:—

1. To empower the Company to raise additional capital by the creation and issue of ordinary stock and to raise further loan capital by borrowing on mortgage and by the creation and issue of debenture stock. To make provision with respect to the mode of issue of any ordinary preference and debenture stock of the Company whether under the powers of their existing Acts and Orders or of the Order and as to the dividends or interest payable thereon, and to make such other provisions with respect to the borrowing powers of the Company as may seem necessary or expedient.
