TOTTENHAM AND DISTRICT GAS.

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the ensuing Session by the Tottenham District Light Heat and Power Company (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") for an Act of which the principal subject matters are as follows:—

To provide for the transfer to and vesting in the Company of the undertaking of the Waltham and Cheshunt Gas Company (hereinafter referred to as "the Waltham Company") and the consideration for such transfer to be given to the holders of shares and stock of the Waltham Company; to extend and apply the enactments of the Company to the district now supplied by the Waltham Company and to repeal with certain exceptions the enactments relating to the Waltham Company; to authorise the Company to exercise the unexercised powers of the Waltham Company of raising money by the issue of capital or by borrowing; provisions as to the Directors, Auditors, Officers and servants of the Waltham Company and for the taking over or payment of compensation to such officers; to authorise the charging by the Company of a higher price or higher prices for gas supplied in the district of the Waltham Company than in the areas now supplied by the Company; dissolution and winding up of the Waltham Company; to change the name of the Company.

To provide for the consolidation and conversion of one or more of the several classes of stock in the existing capital of the Company and to make provision in regard to the dividends whether preferential or ordinary to which the holders of such stock shall be entitled and other incidental matters; to create the stock and capital necessary for the purposes of the intended Act, to authorise the Company to raise additional capital by the issue of stock or by borrowing and to make provision in regard to Special Purposes and Renewal Funds and the application of revenue and profits to the formation of a fund for capital purposes; the issue of redeemable stock, dividends on preference stock, alteration of auction clauses, interim dividends, subscriptions and other financial and administrative provisions.

General provisions in regard to the supply of gas, alteration and repair of dangerous fittings, erection of buildings over gas pipes &c.

To empower the Company to construct works for the manufacture and storage of gas and residual products on certain lands in the neighbourhood of the existing gas works of the Company in the parishes and urban districts of Tottenham and Edmonton in the County of Middlesex, having a total area of 55 acres 1 rood and 3 perches or thereabouts.

Printed copies of the Bill for the intended Act will be deposited in the Committee and Private Bill Office of the House of Commons on or before the 17th day of December 1927 and on and after the 21st day of December 1927 copies of the Bill may be inspected and copies obtained at the price of 4s. for each

SOUTH METROPOLITAN GAS.

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the ensuing Session by the South Metropolitan Gas Company (hereinafter called "the Company") for an Act of which the principal subject matters will be as follows:—

Extension of limits of supply of the Company to include therein the area following (that is to say):—

In the County of London:—

So much of the Metropolitan Borough of Wandsworth as is included within an imaginary line commencing at the point of junction of Streatham Vale with Manor-road drawn thence in a straight line in a northerly direction for a distance of 540 yards, or thereabouts, to a point on the south-easterly side of the Southern Railway 433 yards, or thereabouts, measured along that railway in a south-westerly direction from the south-eastern corner of the bridge carrying the said railway over Eardley-road, drawn thence along the south-easterly side of the said railway to a point thereon 1217 yards, or thereabouts, measured in a south-westerly direction from the said south-eastern corner of the said bridge, and drawn thence along the boundary between the Counties of London and Surrey to the point of commencement.

In the County of Surrey:—

So much of the urban district of Mitcham as is included within an imaginary line commencing at a point on the south-eastern side of the Southern Railway, 1217 yards, or thereabouts, measured along that railway in a south-westerly direction from the south-eastern corner of the said bridge carrying the said railway over Eardley-road, drawn thence along the south-eastern side of the said railway to a point (being the south-west corner of the enclosure next hereinafter mentioned) 83 yards or thereabouts measured in a south-westerly direction from the said point of commencement, drawn thence along the southern boundary of the said enclosure numbered 32 in the said urban district on the $\frac{2500}{100}$ Ordnance Map (Surrey Sheet VII—16, Edition 1913), drawn thence along the south-
