ALDERSHOT DISTRICT ELECTRICITY  
(EXTENSION) SPECIAL ORDER.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Aldershot Gas Water and District Lighting Company (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") whose chief office is situate at Victoria Road, Aldershot in the County of Southampton, intend to apply to the Electricity Commissioners for a Special Order (hereinafter called "the Order") under the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1926 and under the Statutory Gas Companies (Elec-

tricity Supply Powers) Act, 1925 for all or some of the following amongst other purposes, that is to say:—

1. To extend the area within which the Company are authorised to supply electrical energy so as to enable them to provide and distribute electrical energy for all public and private purposes as defined by the said Acts in the following Parishes or parts of Parishes that is to say:—

The Parishes of Holybourne and Neatham and so much of the Parish of Binstead as lies to the west of an imaginary line drawn from Anstey Bridge near the Village of Bentley in a south easterly direction along the west side of the road from Bentley to Blacknest for a distance of 500 yards or thereabouts to the Railway Bridge at Bentley Junction thence in a general southerly direction along the east side of the Bentley and Bordon Light Railway to the boundary of the said Parish.
