

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF

ANIMALS (LANDING FROM IRELAND
AND ISLE OF MAN) ORDER OF 1928
(No. 2).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Detention of Animals moved out of Landing Place.

1.—(1) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Animals (Landing from Ireland and Isle of Man) Order of 1928 or any Order amending it, cattle, sheep, goats or swine shipped from any port in Ireland which is mentioned in the First Schedule to the Animals (Landing from Ireland, Channel Islands, and Isle of Man) Order of 1923 as amended by any subsequent Order, except the ports of Rosslare and Wexford or shipped from the Isle of Man may be landed after the twenty-eighth day of February, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, at any landing place in Great Britain approved by the Minister as a landing place for imported animals, and may be moved from the landing place if accompanied by a licence granted by an Inspector of the Ministry and subject to the following conditions:—

(i) The animals shall be moved to the place of detention specified in the licence and not elsewhere and shall be there detained and slaughtered within a period of ten days after the date of their arrival thereat. Whilst so detained animals moved with a licence under this Order shall not be allowed to come into contact with any other animals.

(ii) Animals moved under this Order shall be moved by the nearest available route, and during such movement shall not be permitted to come in contact with animals not being moved under this Order.

(2) A copy of every licence granted under this Order shall be sent by the Inspector granting the same to the Local Authority of the District in which the place of detention specified in the Licence is situate, who shall take steps to enforce the conditions of the Licence.

Offences.

2. Any person committing, or aiding, abetting, counselling or procuring the commission of any breach of the provisions of this Order, is liable, on summary conviction, to the penalties provided by the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927.

Local Authority to enforce Order.

3. The provisions of this Order, except where it is otherwise provided, shall be executed and enforced by the Local Authority.

Short Title.

4. This Order may be cited as the ANIMALS (LANDING FROM IRELAND AND ISLE OF MAN) ORDER OF 1928 (No. 2).

FOOT - AND - MOUTH DISEASE (IN-
FECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1928
(No. 32).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Extension of Leicester and Warwick Infected Area.

1. The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1928 (No. 30) shall be read and have effect as if the Area described in the Schedule to this Order were included in and formed part of Infected Area (numbered 5A) described in the Second Schedule to that Order.

Commencement and Short Title.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-seventh day of February, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, and may be cited as the FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1928 (No. 32).

*Area added to certain Infected Area.**In the county of Warwick.*

The parishes of Stoneleigh, Kenilworth, Ashow, Bubbenhall, Wappenbury Cubbing-
