

minutes' duration. The charge for each additional minute or fraction of a minute after the first 3 minutes is one-third of the above mentioned charges.

The hours during which the day charges apply are those between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. (legal time of the country in which the call originates). The hours during which the night charges apply are those between 7 p.m. and 8 a.m. (legal time of the country in which the call originates).

In the case of a call from a call office the usual call office fees will be charged in addition to the other charges.

NOTE.—Communication with the Grand Duchy of Luxemburg is at present limited to calls to or from Luxemburg City.

URBAN DISTRICT OF ELLESMERE.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1907,
AND PUBLIC HEALTH ACT, 1925.

BY an Order dated the Second day of March, 1928, the Minister of Health has (1) Ordered that, on and after the 19th day of March, 1928, the following provisions of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, shall be in force in the Urban District of Ellesmere, namely:—

Section 25 (yards to be paved, &c.); and Part IV (infectious diseases); and

(2) Consented to the adoption by the Urban District Council of Ellesmere of the following provisions of the Public Health Act, 1925, namely:—

Section 21 (prevention of water flowing on footpath); and

Section 22 (preventing soil &c. from being washed into streets).

The Order directs that the said adoption shall take effect on the 19th day of March, 1928.

GRAVESEND ELECTRICITY (EXTENSION).

(Extension of Area of Supply of the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Gravesend under the Gravesend Electric Lighting Order 1898 and the Gravesend (Extension to Northfleet) Electric Lighting Order 1905 so as to include the parish of Denton and parts of the parishes of Ifield and Cobham in the Rural District of Strood, in the County of Kent: Provisions as to prices: Power to break up Streets in added areas: Use of Electricity supplied for purposes of Railways, Tramways and Canals: Incorporation of Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act 1899: Amendment or Repeal of said Orders: Miscellaneous and Incidental provisions).

NOTICE is hereby given that the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Gravesend (hereinafter called "the Corporation") whose address is The Town Hall, Gravesend, are applying to the Electricity Commissioners for a Special Order (hereinafter called "the Order" under the Electricity (Supply) Acts 1882 to 1926 for all or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—

To extend the area for the supply of electrical energy by the Corporation so as to enable them to provide and distribute electrical energy for all public and private purposes as defined by the said Acts within the parish of Denton so much of the parish of Ifield as is bounded on the South by Watling Street, on the North by the Municipal Borough of Gravesend on the East by the Urban District of Northfleet and on the West by the said Urban District of Northfleet so much of the parish of Ifield as is bounded on the South by Watling Street on the North by the said Municipal Borough of Gravesend and the parish of Denton on the West by the said Urban District of Northfleet and on the East by the parish of Cobham and so much of the parish of Cobham as lies to the North of Watling Street all in the Rural District of Strood in the County of Kent (hereinafter referred to as "the added areas") and to regulate the prices to be charged for such supplies in the added areas and in the Borough of Gravesend and the Urban District of Northfleet.

To extend and make applicable to the added areas all or some of the powers and provisions contained in the Gravesend Electric Lighting Order 1898, and the Gravesend (Extension to Northfleet) Electric Lighting Order 1905.

The following is a list of the streets not repairable by the local authority and railway in the added areas which the Corporation propose to take power to break up:—
