In witness whereof we have hereunto set our Common Seal this tenth day of May in the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, Do Hereby Grant, subject as hereinafter mentioned, out of the Common Fund under our control to the Vicarage of Christ Church, Luton, in the County of Bedford and in the Diocese of Saint Albans, one capital sum of two thousand three hundred and fifty-five pounds to be applicable towards the cost of redeeming a rent charge of one hundred and six pounds per annum payable out of the revenues of the said Vicarage of Christ Church, Luton in favour of the Vicarage of Saint Saviour, Luton, in the same county and diocese, in accordance with the terms of a Deed dated the sixth day of March in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three; Provided always that the capital sum hereby granted shall be and shall be taken to be in lieu of and in full substitution for the yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and six pounds heretofore payable by us, the said Commissioners, in favour of the said Vicarage of Christ Church, Luton, under the authority of an Instrument which was sealed by us on the eleventh day of February, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five and published in the London Gazette on the nineteenth day of the same month.

BISHOPS STORTFORD HARLOW AND EPPING GAS.

(Application for Special Order under Section 10 of the Gas Regulation Act 1920).

NOTICE is hereby given that the Bishops Stortford Harlow & Epping Gas and Electricity Company (hereinafter called "the Company") whose principal office is situate at Water Lane, Bishops Stortford in the County of Hertford intend to apply to the Board of Trade for a Special Order under Section 10 of the Gas Regulation Act 1920 for all or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—

To authorise the Company to construct and maintain gasworks and to manufacture and store gas and residual and manufactured products upon the lands hereinafter described and to deal in such products. The said lands are:—

A piece of land known as Railway Field and situate in the urban district of Epping in the County of Essex comprising 2½ acres or thereabouts and bounded on the north by the existing works of the Company on the east by the road leading from Epping to Theydon Garnon and known as Bower Road and on the west by property belonging to the London and North Eastern Railway Company.

A piece of land comprising half an acre or thereabouts adjoining Ongar Bridge at Chipping Ongar in the County of Essex bounded on the north by Cripey Brook the south by property belonging to Frank Harding Jones Stanley Hunter Jones and Ethel Mary Jones on the east by the existing works of the Company and on the west by the main road leading from Chipping Ongar to London.

A piece of land situate in Pond Mead Newport in the County of Essex comprising one-third of an acre or thereabouts bounded on the north-west by the existing works of the Company on the west by property belonging to the London and North Eastern Railway Company on the south-east by property belonging to Charles William French and having a frontage of 100 feet or thereabouts to Limekiln Lane near the railway station in Newport aforesaid.

To empower the Company by agreement to purchase take hold and deal with additional lands and to sell and lease any lands belonging to them in connection with their gas undertaking.
