NEW SARUM ELECTRICITY (EXTENSION) SPECIAL ORDER, 1928.

(Applied for under the title of "Salisbury Electricity (Extension) (No. 2) Special Order.")

NOTICE is hereby given that the Electricity Commissioners have submitted to the Minister of Transport for confirmation under the above-mentioned Acts a Special Order made by them for the supply by the Salisbury Electric Light and Supply Company Limited, of electricity within parts of the City of New Sarum and of the Rural District of Salisbury in the county of Wilts.

The Minister of Transport proposes to confirm the Order and gives notice that any person

affected who may be desirous of objecting to the confirmation of the same must in accordance with the Electricity (Confirmation of Special Orders) Rules, 1921, do so by memorial addressed to the Minister of Transport written on one side only of foolscap paper and sent by registered post addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Transport, 6, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W. 1, and posted not later than the 9th day of June, 1928. A copy of any such memorial must also be sent in like manner to Messrs. Godfrey Warr Clarkson and Company, 85, Gracechurch Street, London, E.C. 3, Solicitors for the Order. Such memorial must be sealed or signed by the person objecting or by some responsible and duly authorised person on his behalf and must state the specific grounds of objection to the Order and the modifications desired.

A copy of the Order as submitted for confirmation has been deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Wilts at his office at Trowbridge with the Town Clerk of the City of New Sarum at his office, and with the Clerk to the Rural District Council of Salisbury at his office.
