## SILSDEN ELECTRICITY (No. 2).

NOTICE is hereby given that application has been made to the Electricity Commissioners by the Yorkshire Electric Power Company (hereinafter referred to as "the Undertakers"), whose address is 36, Park Place, Leeds, for a Special Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") under the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1926, for all or some of the following amongst other purposes (that is to say):—

1. To authorise the Undertakers to generate, store, distribute, sell and supply electricity for all or any public or private purposes as defined in the said Acts within the urban district of Silsden in the West Riding of the County of York (hereinafter referred to as "the area of supply").

2. To confer upon the Undertakers the powers or some of the powers contained in the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1926, and the enactments incorporated therewith and to alter vary or extinguish all rights and privileges which would or might interfere with any of the objects of the Order, and to confer other rights and privileges.

3. To incorporate with the Order and make applicable to the area of supply all or some of the provisions contained in the Schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act, 1899, as amended by subsequent Acts with or without modifications.

4. To make provisions as to the price which may be charged by the Undertakers for electricity supplied in the area of supply and as to the methods of charging.

5. To empower the Undertakers to break up certain streets and parts of streets not repairable by the local authority within the area of supply.

6. Copies of the draft Order and Ordnance Maps showing the area of supply have been deposited for public inspection at the office of the Clerk of the Peace for the West Riding of the County of York at the County Hall, Wakefield, and at the office of the Clerk to the Silsden Urban District Council at Silsden.

7. Printed copies of the draft Order as applied for and of the Order when made may be obtained at the offices of the undersigned

and at the office of Mr. J. E. Streets, 39, Kirkgate, Silsden, at the price of two shillings for each copy.

And notice is hereby also given that any authority company body or person being desirous of bringing before the Electricity Commissioners any objection respecting the application must do so by letter sent by registered post addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Savoy Court, Strand, London, W.C. 2, and despatched on or before the 2nd day of October, 1928, and must also forward a copy of any such objection to the undersigned or one of them.

LYTHAM SAINT ANNES ELECTRICITY  
(EXTENSION).

THE Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Lytham Saint Annes (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") whose address is the Town Hall, Lytham Saint Annes, have applied to the Electricity Commissioners under the Electricity (Supply) Acts 1882 to 1926 for a Special Order for the following objects:—

(a) To authorise the Corporation to supply electrical energy for all public and private purposes as defined by the above Acts within the parishes of Bryning-with-Kellamergh, Freckleton and Warton, in the rural district of Fylde, and so much of the parish of Westby-with-Plumpton, in the same rural district, as lies to the south and south-west of an imaginary straight line drawn from the centre of the bridge carrying Lytham Road over Wrea Brook in a west or north-westerly direction to the south-eastern corner of the parish of Marton 100 yards or thereabouts to the north of the north-western corner of Lawns Wood (hereinafter referred to as "the added area").

(b) To empower the Corporation to break up certain streets not repairable by the local authority and railways within the added area.

(c) To extend to the added area such of the provisions of the Lytham Saint Annes Corporation Act, 1923, as relate to electricity; and

(d) To authorise the Corporation to exercise within the added area the powers usually conferred on distributors of electrical energy.
