APPOINTMENT.

AT HENDON CIRCUS AND QUEEN'S ROAD, HENDON

In Two Portions.

Three Hackney Carriages:

First Portion.—At Hendon Circus, South-east side of roadway, one carriage to stand at a point five yards North-east of lamp-post by the junction with Park Road.

Front of vehicle toward the South.

Second Portion.—At Queen's Road, two carriages on the South side of roadway, commencing at a point twenty yards from the junction with Hendon Circus and extending Eastward, by kerb, as far as necessary for two carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the West.

The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.

Provided that no Hackney Carriage shall be suffered to stand across any street or thoroughfare, or opposite the end of any street or carriage-way, or upon any place where foot passengers usually cross the carriage-way.
