THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

SECTION 7.

Whereas by Notice dated the 9th day of August, 1928, published in the London Gazette dated the 10th day of August, 1928, the Minister of Transport, by virtue and in exercise of the powers given to him by Section 7 of the London Traffic Act, 1924, and the Regulations from time to time made by him thereunder, after consulting the London and Home Counties Traffic Advisory Committee, relaxed the restrictions and limitations imposed by the said Regulations upon the occasion of the closing of Blackwall Tunnel to vehicular traffic.

And whereas the Minister proposes further to relax the said restrictions and limitations in respect of every Saturday upon which Blackwall Tunnel is closed to vehicular traffic.
