BIRKENHEAD IMPORTED ANIMALS WHARF ORDER OF 1928 (No. 2).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Definition of Imported Animals Wharf.

1. The premises described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby defined as an Imported Animals Wharf for the purposes of the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and any Order of the Minister thereunder.

Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the eighteenth day of August, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight.

Revocation.

 The Birkenhead Imported Animals Wharf Order of 1928 is hereby revoked.
