## CANCELLATION OF STANDINGS FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGES.

*By virtue of the Act 13 and 14 Victoria, chapter 7, intituled "An Act for Consolidating the Office of the Registrar of Metropolitan Public Carriages with the Office of Commissioners of Police of the Metropolis, and making other provisions in regard to the Consolidated Offices."*

I, WILLIAM THOMAS FRANCIS HORWOOD, Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby CANCEL the appointment of the following Standings for Hackney Carriages at the following places:—

#### Twenty Hackney Carriages :

*First Portion.*—Two carriages to stand on East side of roadway, by kerb, at a point 6 feet from lamp-post at entrance to Sutton Railway Station.

Front of vehicle towards the North.

NOTE.—Of the two carriages on this portion, one shall be mechanically propelled and the other horse-drawn.

*Second Portion.*—Eighteen carriages to stand on West side of roadway, commencing at a point 17 yards from junction with Mulgrave Road, Sutton, extending Southward, by kerb, as far as necessary for eighteen carriages.

Front of vehicle towards the North.

The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.
