## ORDER OF THE REGISTRAR GENERAL IN ENGLAND.

## (Dated 11th September, 1928.)

Whereas under Section 21 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1874, the Registrar General, with the sanction of the Minister of Health, may from time to time alter Registration Sub-districts:—

Now, therefore, I, Sylvanus Percival Vivian, C.B., Registrar General of Births, Deaths and Marriages in England, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Births and Deaths Registration Acts, 1836 to 1901, and with the sanction of the Minister of Health, do hereby order as follows:—

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Liverpool Registration of Births, etc. (Alteration of sub-districts) Order, 1928, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of October, 1928.
- (2) The Toxteth Park East Sub-district of the Liverpool Registration District shall cease to exist and its constituent wards of Liverpool County Borough shall be apportioned as follows:—
  - (a) The Toxteth Park Central Subdistrict of the Liverpool Registration District shall be extended by the addition of the Sefton Park East Ward, and shall be known as the Toxteth Park North Subdistrict.
  - (b) The Toxteth Park West Sub-district of the Liverpool Registration District shall be extended by the addition of the Sefton Park West Ward, and shall be known as the Toxteth Park South Subdistrict.
- (3) The Registrars of the existing Subdistricts of Toxteth Park Central and Toxteth Park West shall respectively be the Registrars of the Toxteth Park North and Toxteth Park South Sub-districts, as constituted by this Order.
