## IN PRIZE

Cargo discharged at Capetown in August, 1916, from the Portuguese steamship "CUNENE," formerly the German steamship "ADELAIDE," seized at Loanda, Portuguese West Africa.

Notice is hereby given to all persons having claims against the cargo scheduled hereunder or any portion thereof that it is intended after the expiration of three months from the date of publication of this notice, to re-open the proceedings instituted in the Prize Court at Capetown for the condemnation of the cargo.

Claimants should communicate with Messrs. Fairbridge Arderne and Lawton, 40, Burg Street, Capetown, at the same time lodging their claims with the Registrar of the Prize Court at Capetown, within the period given.

Conclusive proof of ownership at the time of seizure is required to support any claim.

Claimants are required to certify that their claims have not already been adjudicated by a Portuguese Prize Court and to declare that they elect to have their claims dealt with by the British Prize Court and do so on the undertaking that the finding of such Court is accepted by them without appeal.

In instances where claims are taken into the Court and are rejected, costs may be awarded against the claimants.
