

waters and waterworks, the reservation of water rights and the imposition of conditions upon the user of lands, special charges for water supplied for motor cars and refrigerators and certain classes of premises, the alteration of dates for the payment of water rates, provisions as to communication pipes and common pipes, power to recover summarily money due for fittings &c., increasing the guarantee to be given by consumers under section 35 of the Waterworks Clauses Act 1847, guarantees by local authorities, and the construction and maintenance of water tanks under streets

5. The acquisition of land by agreement in advance of requirements for any purpose of the Corporation and for the benefit of the borough.

6. The borrowing of money by the Corporation for the purposes of the Bill and other financial matters including the use of funds for borrowing, and the formation of a water reserve fund.

7. The incorporation, repeal and amendment of Acts and Orders both general and local and the enactment of all incidental provisions.

Plans and sections of the intended works and plans of the lands intended to be taken for the purposes of the intended Act, together with a book of reference to the plans will on or before the 30th day of November instant be deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the County Palatine of Lancaster at his office at Preston and with the Town Clerk of the borough at his office therein.

Printed copies of the Bill for the intended Act will be deposited in the Committee and Private Bill Office of the House of Commons on or before the 17th day of December next.

On and after the 21st day of December 1928 a copy of the Bill may be inspected and copies obtained at the price of three shillings each at the office of the undermentioned Town Clerk, and copies may also be obtained at the offices of the undermentioned Parliamentary Agents.

A notice stating more fully the objects of the intended application has been published in full in the Warrington Guardian and the Warrington Examiner of the 17th and 24th November, 1928.

LLANFRECHFA UPPER AND LLANTARNAM WATER BOARD.

NOTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the Session of 1928-9 for leave to introduce a Bill for an Act (hereinafter referred to as "the Bill") of which the principal subject matters are as follows:—

Incorporation of a Water Board consisting of representatives of or appointed by the

Llanfrechfa Upper Urban District Council (hereinafter called "the Llanfrechfa Council") and the Llantarnam Urban District Council.

The constitution, proceedings and administration of Board; Transfer to Board of Water Undertaking of Llanfrechfa Council; Consideration for and conditions of transfer.

Repeal or amendment of Llanfrechfa Upper Local Board Waterworks Act 1884.

Power to Board to supply water within the Urban District of Llanfrechfa Upper and the urban district of Llantarnam and to maintain and continue the transferred waterworks and plant.

Power to Board to make and maintain in the County of Monmouth the following works:—

Work No. 1.—A subsiding reservoir in the Urban District of Llanfrechfa Upper the dam of which will be constructed across the Cwmbran Brook at a point on that stream 35 yards or thereabouts measured in a north westerly direction from the north western corner of the enclosure numbered 502 in the parish of Llanfrechfa Upper on the $\frac{1}{2500}$ Ordnance Map Monmouthshire Sheet XXIII. 10 Edition of 1920.

Work No. 2.—An enlargement of the existing Blaen Bran Reservoir in the Urban District of Llanfrechfa Upper by raising and extending the existing dam and by excavating the bed of that reservoir.

Work No. 3.—A service reservoir in the Urban District of Llanfrechfa Upper in the enclosure numbered 507 in the Parish of Llanfrechfa Upper on the said Ordnance Map.

Work No. 3A.—Filter beds in the Urban District of Llanfrechfa Upper in the said enclosure numbered 507.

Work No. 4.—An aqueduct, conduit or line or lines of pipes (1 furlong and 4.8 chains or thereabouts in length) in the Urban District of Llanfrechfa Upper.

Work No. 5.—An aqueduct, conduit or line or lines of pipes (4.2 chains or thereabouts in length) in the Urban District of Llanfrechfa Upper.

Work No. 6.—An aqueduct, conduit or line or lines of pipes (4 furlongs and 7.4 chains or thereabouts in length) in the Urban Districts of Llanfrechfa Upper and Llantarnam and the Parish of Llanfrechfa Lower in the Rural District of Pontypool.

Power to make subsidiary works; Powers of deviation.

Appropriation of waters of the Blaen Bran or Cwmbran Brook and other waters and springs.

Compensation water; Stopping up and breaking up and alteration &c., of streets, roads, &c., and apparatus; Acquisition of lands (including parts of property) and easements by compulsion or agreement; Limitation of compensation; Costs of arbitration; Entry on land for the purposes of survey and valuation; Retention and disposal of lands; Application of Section 12 of Waterworks Clauses Act 1847.
