

the rural district of Reigate, so much of the parish of Charlwood in that district and of the parish of Worth in the rural district of East Grinstead as is comprised in the areas of supply under the Horley and District Electricity Orders 1925 and 1926 and so much of the parish of Runwell in the rural district of Chelmsford as is comprised in the area of supply under the Wickford and District Electricity Special Order 1923.

4. The purchase by the Authority (instead of the local authority) of undertakings authorised by Special Orders applied for before the passing of the Bill or authorised by Special Acts or Orders to be hereafter passed or made.

5. The variation of the period at which and of the terms on which any undertaking within the proposed extended district may be purchased.

6. Agreements between the Authority, authorised undertakers and local authorities relative to the exercise of their powers.

7. The restriction of any power of the Authority to delay exercising a right of purchase transferred to them and the exercise of such right by the Authority on behalf of the local authorities concerned.

8. The variation of the constitution of the Authority to give representation to local authorities whose rights are transferred and to the county and other local authorities concerned.

9. The advancement of money by way of loan by the Authority to authorised undertakers.

10. The division of the district as extended into distribution areas, the formation of joint committees representing the Authority and the local authorities and, if deemed expedient, authorised undertakers and the making of schemes in regard to the matters aforesaid and to the powers and duties of such committees.

11. Price for the supply of electricity in any area.

12. The apportionment of the administrative expenses of the Authority.

13. Compensation for loss of employment.

14. The alteration and repeal of any Acts, public or local, and of Orders relating to the generation or supply of electricity in the district.

Printed copies of the Bill for the intended Act will be deposited in the Committee and Private Bill Office of the House of Commons on or before the 17th day of December next, and on and after the 21st day of December next a copy of the Bill may be inspected at the offices of the undermentioned Clerk and Solicitor, and copies of the Bill may be obtained at a price of two shillings and sixpence each at the offices of the undermentioned Clerk and Solicitor and Parliamentary Agents.

A notice stating the objects of the intended application has been and will be published in full in "The Times" of the 20th and 27th days of November instant.

### METROPOLITAN RAILWAY.

NOTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the Session of 1928-9 by the Metropolitan Railway Company (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") for leave to introduce a Bill for an Act (hereinafter referred to as "the Bill") of which the principal subject matters are as follows:—

Power to Company to make and maintain the following works:—

In the County of Middlesex:—

Work No. 1—A widening of the Company's country extension line from Baker Street to Aylesbury and beyond (2 miles 4 furlongs and 7 chains or thereabouts in length) in the Urban Districts of Harrow-on-the-Hill, Wealdstone and Wembley.

In the Administrative County of London:—

Work No. 2—An enlargement of the tunnel of the Company's Inner Circle Railway (2 chains or thereabouts in length) in the Metropolitan Borough of St. Marylebone.

Work No. 3—An enlargement of the said tunnel (2 chains or thereabouts in length) in the Metropolitan Boroughs of St. Marylebone and St. Pancras.

Work No. 4—An enlargement of the said tunnel (3 chains or thereabouts in length) in the Metropolitan Borough of St. Pancras.

Work No. 5—An enlargement of the tunnel of the said extension line (2 chains or thereabouts in length) in the Metropolitan Borough of St. Marylebone.

Work No. 6—An enlargement of the tunnel of the said extension line (2 chains or thereabouts in length) in the Metropolitan Borough of Hampstead.

Work No. 7—An alteration and lengthening of the bridge carrying St. Chad's Place over the said Inner Circle Railway (1·27 chains or thereabouts in length) in the Metropolitan Borough of St. Pancras.

Work No. 8—An alteration and lengthening of the bridge carrying Wicklow Street over the said Inner Circle Railway (1·36 chains or thereabouts in length) in the Metropolitan Borough of St. Pancras.

Power to make and maintain subsidiary, temporary and permanent workings.

Powers of deviation, Stopping up, breaking up, opening, diverting, interfering with and using temporarily or permanently streets, roads &c., in and adjoining the said Urban Districts and Boroughs.

Removal of liability to maintain roads; Underpinning; Removal and interference with various works and apparatus and user of sewers, drains, and watercourses for the discharge of water during the construction of the intended works; Tolls, rates and charges; Purchase of land and easements by compulsion or agreement.

Acquisition of lands in Metropolitan Borough of Finsbury by compulsion or agreement for enlargement and improvement of existing Aldersgate and Barbican station of Company.
