For the purposes of the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1926, and all Orders and Licenses made or granted and issued thereunder, and any Local Act relating to the supply of electricity, the Electricity Commissioners approve of the construction and pattern of the meter (hereinafter described) for the measurement of electrical energy when supplied on the constant pressure, single phase, alternating current system, and known as the Ferranti Single Phase Watthour Meter, Type "F.C.b" rated sizes from and including 2.5 amperes to 100 amperes, 100 volts to 550 volts, at a frequency of 50 cycles per second.

Provided that the meter be constructed as described in the specification and drawings deposited at the National Physical Laboratory, Teddington, Middlesex, dated and numbered 8th June, 1925, and No. 104, and be in accordance with one of the pattern meters Nos. 1905144, 1905399, 1911069, 1907002 and 3132803, deposited at the National Physical Laboratory on the 2nd June, 1925, 18th June, 1925, 11th July, 1925 and the 29th October, 1928, respectively, by or on behalf of Ferranti Limited, Hollinwood, Lancashire, and sealed by the National Physical Laboratory at the instance of the Electricity Commissioners.

The Electricity Commissioners further approve of the means provided for fixing meters of this description, and for connecting them with the service lines as described in the specification and drawings above referred to.

The approval by the Electricity Commissioners dated the 31st August, 1926, of the construction and pattern of the Ferranti Single

Phase Watthour Meter, Type "F.C.b", rated sizes 2.5 amperes to 20 amperes, 100 volts to 550 volts, at a frequency of 50 cycles per second, and of the means provided of fixing the same and for connecting the same with service lines, is hereby superseded.

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 30TH NOVEMBER, 1928.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1928 (No. 68) as amended by the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Orders of 1928 (Nos. 73 and 77) shall be read and have effect as if that part of the parish of Plymstock, in the county of Devon, which lies to the east of the road running between Spriddlestone Lodge and Ridge Cross (including the road between those points) were excluded from and ceased to form part of the area described in the Schedule to the last mentioned Order.
