The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

**W**HEREAS provision was made by the Juries Order, 1927, with respect to certain matters with respect to which there is power to make provision by Order in Council under the Juries Act, 1922:

And whereas by section six of the Representation of the People (Equal Franchise) Act, 1928, it is provided that the register of electors to be made in the year nineteen hundred and twenty-nine shall come into force on the first day of May, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, instead of on the dates fixed for the several parts of the United Kingdom respectively by the Representation of the People Acts, 1918 to 1926:

And whereas it is expedient to amend the Juries Order, 1927, accordingly:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon Him by the Juries Act, 1922, and of all other powers enabling Him in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. Article 3 and paragraph (2) of Article 4 of the Juries Order, 1927, shall have effect in

relation to the year nineteen hundred and twenty-nine as if the thirtieth day of March were substituted in the said Article and paragraph for the fifteenth day of September.

2. This Order may be cited as the Juries Order, 1928.
