NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1924 TO 1928.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Com-mittee, acting jointly with the Minister of Health, the Scottish Board of Health, and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the National Health Insurance Acts, 1924 to 1928, to make Regulations entitled the National Health Insurance (Approved Societies) Amendment Regulations, 1929;

And that on account of urgency the National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Minister of Health, under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made Regulations entitled the National Health Insurance (Approved Societies) Amendment Regulations (No. 3), 1928, to come into force immediately as provisional regulations, to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act;
