ORDER OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL  
IN ENGLAND.

(Dated 18th March, 1929.)

Whereas under Section 21 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1874, the Registrar-General, with the sanction of the Minister of Health, may from time to time alter Registration Sub-districts:

And whereas by the County of Southampton (Whitehill) Confirmation Order, 1929, which takes effect on the 1st April, 1929, it is enacted, inter alia, that part of the Civil Parish of Greatham in Petersfield Union and Rural District shall be transferred to Alton Union and Rural District and to the newly created Civil Parish of Whitehill:

And whereas it is expedient that certain corresponding alterations should be made in the constitution of the Registration Sub-districts hereinafter mentioned:

Now, therefore, I, Sylvanus Percival Vivian, C.B., Registrar-General of Births, Deaths, and Marriages in England, in exercise of the

powers conferred by the Births and Deaths Registration Acts, 1836 to 1926, and with the sanction of the Minister of Health, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Alton and Petersfield Registration of Births, etc. (Alteration of Sub-districts) Order, 1929, and shall come into operation on the 1st April, 1929.

2. The Interpretation Act, 1889, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The part of the Civil Parish of Great-ham which on the 1st April, 1929, will be transferred by the above recited Order to Alton Union and Rural District and to the newly created Civil Parish of Whitehill shall cease to form part of the Petersfield Sub-district of Petersfield Registration District and shall be added to and form part of the Alton Sub-district of Alton Registration District.

4. The Superintendent Registrar of the existing Alton Registration District shall be the Superintendent Registrar of that Registration District as extended by this Order.

5. The Registrar of the existing Alton Sub-district of Alton Registration District shall be the Registrar of that Sub-district as extended by this Order.
