

Schedule hereto, in any of the streets or parts thereof declared to be "restricted streets" by any Order made by the Minister of Transport under the aforesaid Section of the London Traffic Act, 1924, and forming part of either of the approved routes numbered 190 and 191 such number of journeys with their omnibuses plying for hire in addition to those now made in the maintenance by them of any service or services on any approved route, as may be

necessary for them to maintain the services respectively shown in Column 2 of the said Schedule; provided that nothing herein contained shall be deemed to affect or derogate from the powers of the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis under the provisions of Section 52 of Metropolitan Police Act, 1839, to give directions to constables for keeping order and for preventing any obstruction of the thoroughfares.

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 18TH JUNE, 1929.)

BIRKENHEAD IMPORTED ANIMALS WHARF ORDER OF 1929 (No. 3).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Definition of Imported Animals Wharf.

1. The premises described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby defined as an Imported Animals Wharf for the purposes of the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and any Order of the Minister thereunder.

Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the nineteenth day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.

Revocation of certain Order.

3. The Birkenhead Imported Animals Wharf Order of 1929 (No. 2) is hereby revoked.

Short Title.

4. This Order may be cited as the BIRKENHEAD IMPORTED ANIMALS WHARF ORDER OF 1929 (No. 3).
