*Definition of Imported Animals Wharf.*

1. The premises described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby defined as an Imported Animals Wharf for the purposes of the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and any Order of the Minister thereunder.

*Commencement.*

2. This Order shall come into operation on the twentieth day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.

*Revocation of certain Order.*

3. The Birkenhead Imported Animals Wharf Order of 1929 (No. 3) is hereby revoked.

*Short Title.*

4. This Order may be cited as the BIRKENHEAD IMPORTED ANIMALS WHARF ORDER OF 1929 (No. 4).
