## LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

## SECTION 7.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Transport by virtue and in exercise of the powers given to him by Section 7 of the London Traffic Act, 1924, and the Regulations from time to time made by him thereunder, after consulting the London and Home Counties Traffic Advisory Committee, has relaxed the restrictions and limitations imposed by the said Regulations upon the occasion of the Flower Show and Sports Gala to be held at Barkingside on Saturday, the 27th day of July, 1929, so that nothing in the said Regulations shall prevent any person who is maintaining at the date of this Notice a regular service in accordance with Section 6 of the London Traffic Act, 1924, upon the approved route numbered 26C from making on that day after 12 noon in any of the streets or parts thereof between Cranbrook Park and Barking-side declared to be "restricted streets" by any Order made by the Minister of Transport under the aforesaid Section of the London Traffic Act, 1924, and forming part of the approved route numbered 26E six journeys per hour in each direction with his omnibuses plying for hire in excess of the number of journeys which he may make in those streets or parts thereof under the said Regulations; provided that nothing herein contained shall be deemed to affect or derogate from the powers of the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis under the provisions of Section 52
