The Civil Service Commissioners hereby give notice that an Open Competitive Examination for the situations of Typist and Clerk-Typist in Departments of the Civil Service will be held in Belfast, Birmingham, Bristol, Edinburgh, Glasgow, Leeds, London, Manchester, Newcastle-on-Tyne and Portsmouth, commencing on the 25th March, 1930, under the Regulations dated the 11th November, 1927,

and published in the London Gazette of the same date.

No person will be admitted to Examination from whom the Secretary of the Civil Service Commission has not received on or before the 16th January, 1930, an application, in the Candidate's own handwriting, on the prescribed form, which may be obtained from the Secretary at once.

WEST KENT MAIN SEWERAGE BOARD.

Whereas the West Kent Main Sewerage Board (hereinafter called the Board) have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, partially to repeal, alter or amend the West Kent Main Sewerage Acts of 1875, 1876 and 1879, and the West Kent Main Sewerage Orders, 1886 to 1926, so as:—

(1) To provide that the Urban District Council of Bexley shall be a constituent authority of the Board with power to elect two representatives from among their own members to serve upon the Board;

(2) To provide that the Urban District Council of Crayford shall be a constituent authority of the Board with power to elect one representative from among their own members to serve upon the Board;

(3) To provide for the cancellations of the agreements dated respectively the 24th day of July, 1891, the 27th day of March, 1901, and the 11th day of July, 1904, made between the Board and the Urban District Council of Bexley for the carrying away and disposal of the sewage from the area now comprising the urban district of Bexley, and of the agreement dated the 10th day of October, 1901, made between the Board and the Rural District Council of Dartford having reference to the reception and disposal of the sewage from the parish of Crayford;

(4) For the several purposes of the Application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Acts and Orders or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875, and in force in the Sewerage District as may be necessary or desirable:

And whereas it is proposed that a Provisional Order should be issued in compliance with the said Application;

Notice is hereby given that H. S. Hunter, Esq., one of the Inspectors of the Ministry of Health, will attend at Park House, Bromley, on Tuesday, the seventeenth day of December, 1929, at eleven o'clock in the forenoon, to hold a Local Inquiry into the subject-matter of the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.

And notice is hereby further given that any person interested may attend at such Inquiry and be heard with reference to the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.
