CANCELLATION OF A STANDING FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGES.

By virtue of the Act 13 and 14 Victoria, chapter 7, intituled "An Act for Consolidating the Office of the Registrar of Metropolitan Public Carriages with the Office of Commissioners of Police of the Metropolis, and making other provisions in regard to the Consolidated Offices."

I, the undersigned, Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby CANCEL the appointment of the following Standing for Hackney Carriages at the following place:—

CANCELLATION.

AT RAILTON ROAD AND DULWICH ROAD, HERNE HILL.

In two portions.

Eleven Hackney Carriages.

First Portion.—Three carriages in the centre of Railton Road, commencing at the end of Herne Hill Railway Station, and extending Southwards.

Front of vehicles facing North.

Second Portion.—Eight carriages on the South side of Dulwich Road, commencing opposite No. 153, and extending Westward by kerb.

Front of vehicles facing East.

The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.
