1. This Order may be cited as the Middlesbrough Registration of Births, etc. (Alteration of Sub-districts) Order, 1930, and shall come into operation on the first day of February, 1930.

2. The Interpretation Act, 1889, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The part of the Ayresome Ward of the County Borough of Middlesbrough (formerly part of Linthorpe Civil Parish) which is at present in the Thornaby Sub-district of Middlesbrough Registration District shall be added to and form part of the Middlesbrough West Sub-district of the same Registration District.

4. The part of the Linthorpe Ward of the County Borough of Middlesbrough (formerly part of Linthorpe Civil Parish) which is at present in the Thornaby Sub-district of Middlesbrough Registration District shall be

added to and form part of the Middlesbrough East Sub-district of the same Registration District.

5. The part of the Grove Hill Ward of the County Borough of Middlesbrough (formerly part of Marton Civil Parish) which is at present in the Ormesby Sub-district of Middlesbrough Registration District shall be added to and form part of the Middlesbrough East Sub-district of the same Registration District.

6. The Registrars of the existing Middlesbrough East and Middlesbrough West Sub-districts shall be respectively the Registrars of those Sub-districts as extended by this Order.

NOTICE is hereby given that by an Order dated the 13th day of January, 1930, the Minister of Health has confirmed an Order

made on the 4th day of December, 1929, by the Town Council of the Borough of Nuneaton in pursuance of Section 112 of the Public Health Act, 1875, as amended by Section 51 of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, declaring each of the following trades, businesses or manufactures, namely the trades, businesses or manufactures of a Blood Drier, a Tanner, a Leather Dresser, a Fat Melter or Fat Extractor, a Glue Maker, a Size Maker, a Gut Scraper, a Rag and Bone Dealer, and a Fish Frier within the said Borough to be an offensive trade.
