TOTTENHAM AND DISTRICT GAS.

Application for Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts, 1920 and 1929.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Tottenham and District Gas Company (hereinafter called "the Company") whose chief office is situate at 639, High Road, Tottenham, in the County of Middlesex, intend to apply to the Board of Trade for a Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts, 1920 and 1929, for all or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—

To authorise the Company to construct and maintain works for the storage of gas upon the land hereinafter described namely:—

A piece of land situate in the Urban District of Enfield in the County of Middlesex and lying near to the north side of Carterhatch Lane near to the west side of the London & North Eastern Railway and bounded on the north and east sides thereof by land belonging or reputed to belong to the Enfield Urban District Council on the south partly by land belonging or reputed to belong to the Enfield Urban District Council and partly by Carterhatch Lane and on the west by the field or enclosure numbered 1299 on the ¹/₂₅₀₀ Ordnance Survey of the parish of Enfield Edition of 1913 Sheet VII 4.

To authorise the Company to purchase by agreement additional lands for the general purposes of its undertaking and to make provision with respect to the retention and disposal of such lands.

To make new provisions with respect to the closing of the Transfer Books of the Company.

To vary and extinguish all rights and privileges which would or might interfere with the objects of the intended Order and to confer other rights and privileges.

To incorporate and apply with or without modification all or some of the provisions of the Gasworks Clauses Acts, 1847 and 1871, and the Lands Clauses Acts and to repeal or amend any of the provisions of the Tottenham and District Gas Acts and Orders, 1859 to 1928, and in particular to repeal the provisions of Section 33 of the Enfield Gas Act, 1867, so far as such Section would empower the Company to erect a Gas-holder in Enfield Town.

A copy of the draft order, a map showing the lands proposed to be used for the storage of gas and a map showing the existing limits of supply of the Company and the situation of the existing and proposed works of the company have been deposited for public inspection at the office of the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Middlesex at the Guildhall Westminster the office of the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Hertford at Hertford and at the office of the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Essex at Chelmsford and also at the office of the Company above mentioned.

Printed copies of the draft order may be obtained at the price of one shilling per copy at the Chief Office of the Company and at the offices of the undersigned Solicitors and Parliamentary Agents.

Any Local or other Public Authority, company or person desiring to bring before the Board of Trade any objection to the draft order may do so by registered letter addressed to the Director of Gas Administration, Board of Trade, Great George Street, London, S.W. 1, and despatched on or before the fourth day of April, 1930, any such objection shall state:—

- (a) the specific grounds of objection; and
- (b) the omissions additions or modifications asked for.

A copy of the objection must be forwarded to the undersigned Solicitors and Parliamentary Agents at the same time as it is sent to the Board of Trade.
