

route shown in Column 1 of the second Schedule hereto from using, for the purpose of plying for hire in any of the streets or parts thereof declared to be "restricted streets" by any Order made by the Minister of Transport under the aforesaid Section of the London Traffic Act, 1924, and forming part of those routes, such number of omnibuses as shown in Column 2 of the said second Schedule additional to the number of omnibuses which he may so use in those

streets or parts thereof under the said Regulations;

provided that nothing herein contained shall be deemed to affect or derogate from the powers of the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis under the provisions of Section 52 of the Metropolitan Police Act, 1839, to give directions to constables for keeping order and for preventing any obstruction to the thoroughfares.

IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.
