#### MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT.

IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT,  
1924.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 7 of the aforesaid London Traffic Act to make Regulations amending the London Traffic (Restricted Streets) Regulations.

And notice is hereby further given that on account of urgency the Minister of Transport has under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made the London Traffic (Restricted Streets) Amendment (Routes Nos. 18E and 518) Provisional Regulations, 1930, to come into operation forthwith as Provisional Regulations to continue in force until Regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act.

These Regulations provide for the operation of certain additional omnibus journeys on Route No. 18E (London Bridge and Stonebridge Park), and the operation of a service of omnibuses between Stonebridge Park and Preston Road Station on Route No. 518 (London Bridge and Preston Road Station).
