

apples imported or suspected to have been imported from any country other than Scotland, Ireland, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man; any person wilfully obstructing or impeding an Inspector in the exercise of these powers, or failing to comply with the provisions relating to destruction or re-exportation, or with the terms of a licence is liable to a penalty of £10 or, in respect of a second or subsequent offence, to a penalty of £50.

The Order comes into operation on the 7th July, 1930.
