

APPOINTMENT OF A STANDING FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGES WITHIN THE METROPOLITAN POLICE DISTRICT, AND REGULATIONS TO BE OBSERVED.

By virtue of the Act 13 and 14 Victoria, chapter 7, intituled "An Act for Consolidating the Office of the Registrar of Metropolitan Public Carriages with the Office of Commissioners of Police of the Metropolis, and making other provisions in regard to the Consolidated Offices."

I, the undersigned, Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby APPOINT a Standing for Hackney Carriages at the following place, and do make the following Regulations with regard to the Boundaries for the same, viz. :—

AT ORMONDE GATE, CHELSEA,

Ten Hackney Carriages:

On the East side of roadway, by the railings of Burton Court, commencing at a point twenty-five feet North of the Northern building line of Royal Hospital Road and extending Northward, by kerb, as far as necessary for ten carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the South.

Provided that no Hackney Carriage shall be suffered to stand across any street or thoroughfare, or opposite the end of any street or carriage-way, or upon any place where foot passengers usually cross the carriage-way.
