At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 27th day of October, 1930.

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS there was this day read at the Board a Memorial from the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, dated the 26th day of August, 1930 (N. 2651/30), in the words following, viz. :—

“Whereas by Section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act, 1865, it is enacted, inter alia, that all pay, pensions, or other allowances in the nature thereof, payable in respect of services in Your Majesty's Naval or Marine Force to a person being or having been an Officer, Seaman, or Marine therein, shall be paid in such manner, and subject to such restrictions, conditions, and provisions, as are from time to time directed by Order in Council :

“And whereas we consider that for the greater efficiency of the Physical and Recreational Training Branch of the Royal Navy the rates of the allowances to men qualified as Physical and Recreational Training Instructors, 1st Class and 2nd Class, as laid down in Your Order in Council dated the 21st December, 1920, should be increased :

“We beg leave humbly to recommend that Your Majesty may be graciously pleased, by Your Order in Council, to sanction the payment, as from the 2nd August, 1930, of non-substantive pay at the following rates to Naval ratings and Royal Marines qualified as Physical and Recreational Training Instructors :—

* Senior Staff Physical and Recreational Training Instructor—2s. a day.

* Staff Physical and Recreational Training Instructor—1s. 6d. a day.

Physical and Recreational Training Instructor, 1st Class—1s. 3d. a day.

Physical and Recreational Training Instructor, 2nd Class—9d. a day.

* Payable whilst holding the appointment.

“The Lords Commissioners of Your Majesty's Treasury have signified their concurrence in this proposal.”

His Majesty, having taken the said Memorial into consideration, was pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to approve of what is therein proposed.

And the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty are to give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
