CENTRAL ELECTRICITY BOARD

NOTICE is hereby given that application has been made to the Electricity Commissioners by the Central Electricity Board, whose principal office is at Trafalgar Buildings, 1, Charing Cross, London, W.C. 2, for a Special Order under the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1928, for all or some of the following purposes, that is to say—

To authorise the Central Electricity Board in the exercise of their powers and duties under the Electricity (Supply) Act, 1926, to acquire hold and use compulsorily or by agreement easements or other rights in and over the lands (or some part thereof) in the Parish of Tipton in the County of Stafford hereinafter described for the purpose of the construction maintenance and use of overhead main transmission lines with all necessary and convenient towers or other supports and equipment.

The lands hereinbefore referred to.

The following lands in the Parish of Tipton in the County of Stafford and known by the following descriptions respectively:—

- Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4, Doe Bank Road and pathways leading thereto;
- Nos. 48, 49 and 50, Leabrook Road and "Onchan," Leabrook Road;
- Nos. 128, 129, 129A, 129B, 130, 131 and 132, Leabrook Road;
- Nos. 133, 134 and 135, Leabrook Road and the stables at the rear thereof;

Nos. 136, 137, 138, 139 and 140, Leabrook Road.

A copy of the draft Special Order and a plan showing the said lands in and over which the said easements or other rights are required and a book of reference to such plan have been deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Stafford at his office at County Buildings, Stafford, and with the Tipton Urban District Council at Public Offices, Tipton.

Any authority, company, body or person desirous of bringing before the Electricity Commissioners any objections respecting the said application must do so by letter sent by registered post addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Savoy Court, Strand, London, W.C. 2, and despatched on or before the 9th day of December, 1930, and a copy of any such objections must at the same time be forwarded to the Secretary and Solicitor of the Central Electricity Board, Trafalgar Buildings, 1, Charing Cross, London, W.C. 2.
