COLCHESTER ELECTRICITY (EXTENSION) (SPECIAL ORDER).

(The supply of Electricity by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Colchester in the Urban District of Walton-on-the-Naze in the County of Essex.)

NOTICE is hereby given that the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Colchester (hereinafter called "the Corporation") whose address is the Town Clerk's Office, Colchester, intend to apply to the Electricity Commissioners for a Special Order (hereinafter called "the Order") under the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1928, for all or some of the following amongst other purposes (that is to say):—

1. To extend the area of supply under the Colchester Electricity Orders, 1893 and 1928 by adding thereto the Urban District of Walton-on-the-Naze.

The area so proposed to be added to the said area of supply is hereinafter referred to as "the added Area."

2. To authorise the Corporation to generate and supply electricity for all public and private purposes as defined by the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1928, within all portions of the added area.

3. To extend and make applicable to the added area all or some of the provisions contained in the Colchester Electricity Orders, 1893 and 1928, and to apply such provisions to the undertaking to be authorised by the Order subject to such variations and exceptions as may be contained therein.

4. To empower the Corporation to purchase from the Walton-on-the-Naze Urban District Council the undertaking authorised by the Walton-on-the-Naze Electric Lighting Order, 1909, and to authorise that Council to sell the same to the Corporation; To provide for the revocation, repeal or amendment of the said Order of 1909; to make provision as to the date upon which the Order shall come into operation; and to authorise the borrowing of any necessary moneys by the Corporation for the purposes aforesaid or any of them.

5. To repeal, alter, extend or amend the provisions of the Colchester Electricity Orders, 1893 and 1928, or some of those provisions, and to incorporate in the Order such of the provisions contained in the Schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act, 1899, as are applicable and to extend some or all of such provisions to the purposes of the said Order of 1893.

6. To authorise the Corporation to open, break up and interfere with all streets, roads and public places, ways, footpaths, bridges, culverts, sewers, drains and gas and water mains and pipes and telegraph and telephone and other wires within the area of supply, and to lay down, erect, maintain, renew and remove either above or under ground or otherwise electric lines, conductors, mains, pipes, tubes, wires, posts, street or distributing boxes, meters, apparatus or other works or things required for the purpose of enabling the Corporation to generate, supply, store, convey, transmit or distribute electricity within the added area, and to confer all such other powers upon the Corporation as may be necessary for effecting the objects of the proposed undertaking.

7. To prescribe the maximum price or maximum prices that may be demanded and taken by the Corporation in respect of the supply of electrical energy within the added area, and to prescribe the minimum prices to be paid by persons supplied with electricity by the Corporation or connected to their electricity undertaking in that area.

8. To authorise the Corporation to open and break up in the added area streets and parts of streets which are not repairable by the Local Authority.

9. To confer upon the Corporation all or some of the powers of the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1928, and the enactments incorporated therewith, and to alter, vary or extinguish all rights and privileges which would, or might, interfere with any of the objects of the Order, and to confer all other rights and privileges necessary for carrying such objects into effect.

Printed copies of the draft Special Order as applied for may be obtained at the offices of the undersigned Town Clerk and Parliamentary Agents, and at the Electricity Office and Showroom, 1, Mill Lane, Walton-on-the-Naze, on payment of two shillings for each copy.

And notice is hereby given that copies of the draft Order and of an ordnance map showing the added area have been deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Essex at his office at Chelmsford, with the Clerk to the Walton-on-the-Naze Urban District Council at his office at Walton-on-the-Naze and with the undersigned Town Clerk at his office in the Town Hall, Colchester.

Any authority, company, body or person desirous of bringing before the Electricity Commissioners any objections respecting the application must do so by letter sent by registered post addressed to the Secretary of the Electricity Commission, Savoy Court, Strand, W.C., and despatched on or before the 24th day of December, 1930, and a copy of such
