Twelve Hackney Carriages: First Portion .- Three carriages on the West side of roadway, commencing at a point in line with the South entrance to the Bakerloo Tube Station and extending Northward, by kerb, as far as necessary for three carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the South.

Second Portion.—Nine carriages on the West side of roadway, commencing at a point six feet North of the North entrance to the Public Convenience and extending Northward, by kerb, as far as necessary for nine carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the South.

The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.

Provided that no Hackney Carriage shall be suffered to stand across any street or thoroughfare, or opposite the end of any street or carriage-way, or upon any place where foot passengers usually cross the carriage-way.
