

1930, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

“ We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in pursuance of the Act of the 16th and 17th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 50, and of the Act of the 23rd and 24th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 124, have prepared, and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Scheme for effecting an exchange of the Patronage of the Benefice (being a Vicarage) of Bury, situate in the County of Sussex and in the Diocese of Chichester, for the alternate Patronage of the United Benefice (being a Rectory) of Coln Rogers with Coln Saint Denis, situate in the County of Gloucester, and in the Diocese of Gloucester :

“ Whereas the Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of Bury is vested in the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of Gloucester (hereinafter called ‘ the said Dean and Chapter ’):

“ And whereas one moiety of the Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said United Benefice of Coln Rogers with Coln Saint Denis is vested in the Master, Fellows and Scholars of Pembroke College, in the University of Oxford (hereinafter called ‘ the said Master, Fellows and Scholars ’):

“ And whereas the remaining moiety of the Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said United Benefice of Coln Rogers with Coln Saint Denis is already vested in the said Dean and Chapter :

“ And whereas the said Dean and Chapter and the said Master, Fellows, and Scholars, have respectively signified to us their desire that the Patronage of the said Benefice of Bury and of the said United Benefice of Coln Rogers with Coln Saint Denis may be re-arranged by way of exchange in the manner which is hereinafter recommended and proposed :

“ And whereas we have made due inquiry and calculation as to the circumstances and relative value of the said two Benefices and

of the Patronage thereof respectively and we do hereby certify to Your Majesty in Council that the circumstances and present values of the said two Benefices are as set forth in the Schedule hereunto annexed :

“ Now, therefore, with the consent of the said Dean and Chapter (in testimony whereof they have caused their Common or Capitular Seal to be affixed to this Scheme) and with the consent of the said Master, Fellows and Scholars (in testimony whereof they have caused their Common or Collegiate Seal to be affixed to this Scheme) we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, humbly recommend and propose that upon and from the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme and without any conveyance or assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the whole Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of Bury and the Church thereof shall be assigned and transferred from the said Dean and Chapter of Gloucester and shall become and be absolutely vested in and shall and may from time to time and at all times be exercised by the said Master, Fellows, and Scholars of Pembroke College in the University of Oxford, and that in exchange for the same the said moiety of the Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said United Benefice of Coln Rogers with Coln Saint Denis and the Churches thereof which is now vested in the said Master, Fellows, and Scholars as aforesaid shall in like manner and upon and from the same date be assigned and transferred from the said Master, Fellows and Scholars and shall become and be absolutely vested in and shall and may from time to time and at all times be exercised by the said Dean and Chapter of Gloucester for ever.

“ And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts, or of either of them, or of any other Act of Parliament.
