

do in pursuance of the twenty-sixth section of an Act of Parliament of the First and Second years of the reign of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Cap. 106, hereby represent to Your Grace as follows:—

"1. There is in the County of York and Diocese of Sheffield the Vicarage of Thurnscoe the Parish whereof contains according to the last census a population of 4,988 people.

"The nett annual value of the Benefice of Thurnscoe is £553.

"The Patronage of the said Vicarage is vested in William Charles de Meuron Earl Fitzwilliam and the Reverend Henry George Wheeler is the present Vicar thereof.

"2. There is also in the said County and Diocese the Vicarage of Clayton with Frickley the Parish whereof contains according to the last census a population of 290 people.

"The nett annual value of the Benefice of Clayton with Frickley is £350.

"The Patronage of the said Vicarage is vested in John Ralph Patientius Warde-Aldam and the Reverend Charles Thomas Belcher Wilkinson is the present Vicar thereof.

"3. There is also in the said County and Diocese the Vicarage of St. George Doncaster the Parish whereof contains according to the last census a population of 5,638 people.

"The nett annual value of the Benefice of St. George Doncaster is £700.

"The Patronage of the said Vicarage is vested in the Lord Bishop of Sheffield and the Reverend Canon Richard Brook is the present Vicar thereof.

"4. There is also in the said County and Diocese the Vicarage of Arksey the Parish whereof contains according to the last census a population of 709 people.

"The nett annual value of the Vicarage of Arksey is £300.

"The Patronage of the said Vicarage is vested in George Gavin Burn and the Reverend John Pierce Price is the present Vicar thereof.

"5. There is also in the said County and Diocese the Vicarage of Kirk Sandall the Parish whereof contains according to the last census a population of 497 people.

"The nett annual value of the Benefice of Kirk Sandall is £550.

"The Patronage of the said Vicarage is vested in the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain and the Reverend George Cecil Francis Soden is the present Vicar thereof.

"6. There is also in the said County and Diocese the Vicarage of Barnby Dun the Parish whereof contains according to the last census a population of 852 people.

"The nett annual value of the Benefice of Barnby Dun is £234.

"The Patronage of the said Vicarage is vested in the Reverend Thomas Killam Killam and the Reverend Canon Thomas Forster Rolfe is the present Vicar thereof.

"7. It appears to us under the provisions of the said Act of the First and Second Vict., Cap. 106, and the Act of the Second and Third years of the same reign, Cap. 49, the following alterations of the contents and boundaries of the above mentioned Parishes may advantageously be made, such alterations being in our opinion desirable owing to the fact that portions of the Parishes hereinafter more par-

ticularly referred to are in each case nearer to the Parish Church of the Parish to which it is proposed to annex the same than to the Parish Church of the Parish to which they now belong and that such alterations will be for the convenience of the inhabitants of such portions.

"8. The separation of that part of the Parish of Thurnscoe which is coloured pink on the plan Number 1 attached hereto from that Parish and the annexation of the same to the Parish of Clayton with Frickley adjoining.

"9. The separation of that part of the Parish of St. George Doncaster which is coloured red on the plan Number 2 attached hereto from that Parish and the annexation of the same to the adjoining Parish of Arksey.

"10. The separation of that part of the Parish of Barnby Dun which is coloured blue on the plan Number 3 attached hereto from that Parish and the annexation of the same to the adjoining Parish of Kirk Sandall.

"11. The separation of those parts of the Parish of St. George Doncaster which are edged round with blue on the said plan Number 3 and are known as Long Sandall from that Parish and the annexation of the same to the Parish of Kirk Sandall.

"12. Pursuant to the directions contained in the 26th Section of the said first mentioned Act of Parliament we the said Lord Bishop of Sheffield have drawn up a Scheme in writing annexed to this Representation describing the portions of Parishes above referred to and the mode in which it appears to us the alterations may be best effected and how the changes consequent thereon in respect of the Ecclesiastical jurisdiction, glebe dues and payments and in respect of the Patronage and the rights to pews may be made with justice to all parties concerned and we do hereby submit the same to your Grace together with the Consents in writing of the said Patrons and Incumbents and in case you shall, on full consideration and enquiry be satisfied therewith we request that your Grace will be pleased to certify the same with the consents aforesaid by your report to His Majesty in Council."

And whereas the said Scheme drawn up by the said Bishop and the Consents referred to in the said Representation are as follows:—

"SCHEME.

"1. It is proposed to separate that part of the Parish of Thurnscoe which is coloured pink on the plan Number 1 attached hereto and to annex the same for Ecclesiastical purposes to the adjoining Parish of Clayton with Frickley.

"2. It is also proposed to separate that part of the Parish of St. George Doncaster which is coloured red on the plan Number 2 attached hereto from that Parish and to annex the same for Ecclesiastical purposes to the adjoining Parish of Arksey.

"3. It is also proposed to separate that part of the Parish of Barnby Dun which is coloured blue on the plan Number 3 attached hereto from that Parish and to annex the same to the adjoining Parish of Kirk Sandall.

"4. It is also proposed to separate those parts of the Parish of St. George Doncaster which are edged round with blue on the said
