STAMPED OR PRESSED METAL WARES
TRADE BOARD (GREAT BRITAIN).VARIATION OF MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES FOR
CERTAIN CLASSES OF MALE AND FEMALE
WORKERS.

The Stamped or Pressed Metal Wares Trade Board (Great Britain) have issued a Notice Q. (36), dated 12th May, 1931, setting out Minimum Rates of Wages for certain classes of Male and Female Workers as varied by the Trade Board and confirmed by Order of the Minister of Labour to take effect as from 18th May, 1931, together with the Minimum Rates of Wages previously in operation which are unaffected by the variation.
