STEPHEN'S CLUB.</p> <p><i>In two portions.</i></p>	<p>Fifteen Hackney Carriages:  <i>First Portion.</i>—Three carriages to stand in centre of roadway Victoria Embankment, commencing at second refuge opposite St. Stephen's Club and extending Northward; front of vehicles facing South.  <i>Second Portion.</i>—Twelve carriages on West side of Embankment next to kerb, commencing ten yards North of entrance to Lost Property Office, New Scotland Yard; front of vehicles facing South.          The first portion to be fed exclusively by carriages from second portion, but first cab on second portion to be entitled to any hiring arising between it and head of first portion,</p>
