

Beckenham, should be altered in the manner which is hereinafter mentioned:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Martin Linton, Bishop of Rochester (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme or Representation), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly represent, recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of an Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme or Representation and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the boundaries of the said New Parish of Christ Church, Beckenham, and of the said New Parish of Saint James, Elmers End, Beckenham, shall be altered so that (first) all that portion of the said New Parish of Christ Church, Beckenham, which is described in the First Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto annexed and is thereon coloured green shall be dissevered from such New Parish and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Saint James, Elmers End, Beckenham, and (secondly) all that portion of the said New Parish of Saint James, Elmers End, Beckenham, which is described in the Second Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the said map or plan hereunto annexed and is thereon coloured pink shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Christ Church, Beckenham:

"And we further represent, recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing, recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts, or of any of them or of any other Act of Parliament.

"THE SCHEDULES to which the foregoing Scheme has reference.

*"The First Schedule.*

"The territory to be dissevered from the New Parish of Christ Church, Beckenham, in the County of Kent, and in the Diocese of Rochester, and to be annexed to the New Parish of Saint James, Elmers End, Beckenham, in the said County and Diocese, being:—

"All that portion of the said New Parish of Christ Church, Beckenham, which is bounded upon the south west and upon the north west by the said New Parish of Saint James, Elmers End, Beckenham, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the north east and upon the east, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint James, Elmers End, Beckenham, from the said New Parish of Christ Church, Beckenham, at the junction of Croydon Road with Groveland Road, and extending thence south eastward along the middle of Groveland Road for a distance of 5 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Broomfield Road, and extending thence south westward along the middle of Broomfield Road for a distance of 16 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Eden Park Avenue, and extending thence south eastward along the middle of Eden Park Avenue for a

distance of 17½ chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Christ Church, Beckenham, from the said New Parish of Saint James, Elmers End, Beckenham.

*"The Second Schedule.*

"The territory to be dissevered from the said New Parish of Saint James, Elmers End, Beckenham, and to be annexed to the said New Parish of Christ Church, Beckenham, being:—

"All that portion of the said New Parish of Saint James, Elmers End, Beckenham, which is bounded upon the south west by the Parish of Addington, in the County of Surrey and in the Diocese of Canterbury, upon the south by the Parish of West Wickham, in the said County of Kent and in the said Diocese of Canterbury, upon the east by the New Parish of Saint Barnabas, Beckenham, in the said County of Kent and in the said Diocese of Rochester, upon the north and upon the northwest by the said New Parish of Christ Church, Beckenham, and upon the remaining side, that is to say, upon the west, by an imaginary line commencing at the point where the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Christ Church, Beckenham, from the said New Parish of Saint James, Elmers End, Beckenham, crosses the middle of Eden Park Avenue, and extending thence south eastward along the middle of Eden Park Avenue for a distance of 2 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Stanhope Grove and extending thence southward along the middle of Stanhope Grove for a distance of 25½ chains or thereabouts to its junction with Upper Elmers End Road, and extending thence westward along the middle of Upper Elmers End Road for a distance of 3½ chains or thereabouts to a point opposite to where Shirley Stream diverges southward from such road, and extending thence southward to and along the middle of Shirley Stream for a distance of 22 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint James, Elmers End, Beckenham, from the said Parish of Addington."

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme or Representation have been transmitted to the Patrons and to the Incumbents of the Cures affected by the arrangements which are contemplated by such Scheme or Representation and such Patrons and Incumbents have respectively signified their assent thereto:

And whereas the said Scheme or Representation has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said Scheme or Representation, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts.

And His Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said Diocese of Rochester.
